AGREED ORDER
ON JOINT OBJECTION TO CLAIM NO. 6

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on June 18, 2007 at 2:00 p.m. upon various scheduled hearings, including the post-confirmation status conference [C.P. # 296], and the Court, having heard from counsel, having been advised that the Debtor and Patricia A. Finch-Junk have agreed to compromise the pending joint objection to Claim No. 6 (which is the only unresolved claim objection), having determined that good and sufficient cause exist in support of waiving notice of the compromise, having further determined that good and sufficient cause exist in support of the relief requested, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. Claim No. 6 filed by Patricia A. Finch-Junk ("Claimant") is allowed as an unsecured, non-priority claim in the amount of \$584.88 (the "Claim").
2. In full and complete satisfaction of the Claim, Patricia A. Finch-Junk shall be entitled to a lump-sum distribution in the amount of \$292.44 (the "Distribution").
3. The Distribution shall be made by Debtor's counsel, as disbursing agent under the Order Confirming First Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization of Debtor and American Capital Holdings, Inc., as modified, Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1129 (C.P. # 295).
4. Upon receipt of the Distribution, the Claimant shall immediately surrender any and all shares of common stock held by Claimant and Thomas D. Finch, Jr. in the Debtor, and such shares shall otherwise be deemed immediately canceled, surrendered and extinguished.
5. **Claimant shall have twenty (20) days from the date of service of this order within which to file a motion for rehearing with the Court in the event Claimant disagrees with the terms hereof. A copy of this Order shall be sent by certified mail with return receipt requested, a copy of which shall be filed with the Court by Debtor's counsel.**
